GRADUATE APPLICATION PROCESS

STEP 1: Apply to the University

Submit the California State University common application and \$70 application fee electronically at calstate.edu/apply beginning October 1.

The Cal State Apply application must be submitted before you submit transcripts.

STEP 2: Submit Documents to Graduate Admissions

- 1. Official transcripts** (in sealed envelopes), issued within the past year, from all U.S. postsecondary institutions attended.
 - **Do not** send transcripts before submitting the Cal State Apply application as this may result in processing delays.
 - If you previously attended SDSU, you only need to submit transcripts for work completed since last attendance. Hard copy SDSU transcripts are not required.
- 2. International documents:** If you have international coursework, you must submit one record of all academic coursework and proof of degree, both in the original language. For each document, you must also send a certified literal English translation, which can be from the school itself or from a professional, certified translator. The translation must contain all information shown on the original-language documents and in the same format. Unofficial copies of academic coursework and proof of degree can be submitted for evaluation purposes. If admitted, official documents will be required prior to enrollment.
- 3. Test scores:** Submit official TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, or PTE scores to SDSU if postsecondary instruction was in a language other than English.

STEP 3: Submit to the Department

All materials required by the department (e.g., letters of recommendation, work samples, resume, departmental application).

** Nonresident tuition is based on 9 units each semester at \$396 per unit.

*** Plan for additional expenses that will increase your cost of attendance. For graduate students, we estimate the average annual cost of books and supplies to be \$1,969; transportation to be \$2,316, and personal expenses to be \$1,704. If these amounts match your personal situation, then you would add them to the overall cost of attendance listed above.

Cost of Attendance Note

The CSU makes every effort to keep student costs to a minimum. Fees listed in published schedules or student accounts may need to be increased when public funding is inadequate. Changes in mandatory systemwide fees will be made in accordance with the requirements of the Working Families Student Fee Transparency and Accountability Act (Sections 66028-66028.6 of the Education Code).
