

TRANSFER STEPS TO ENROLL

Welcome, Class of 2021!

As an admitted transfer student, you must complete the following steps to finalize your admission. For detailed instructions on each step, please visit www.sdsu.edu/admittedtransfers.

Step 1: Complete the Intent to Enroll Process

Reserve your place in the class of 2021 by submitting the online Intent to Enroll \$400 **nonrefundable** deposit in your SDSU WebPortal at www.sdsu.edu/portal. Additionally, please send official copies of transcript(s) from all colleges you have attended. Transcripts including fall 2018 grades are due May 1, 2019 and transcripts including spring 2019 grades are due June 30, 2019. Please note that SDSU will accept only electronic transcripts from the schools listed at www.sdsu.edu/electronictranscripts. Also, you will need to send official Advanced Placement and IB scores, if applicable.

Step 2: Activate Your SDSUid

Once you submit your Intent to Enroll, you will receive an email with instructions on how to activate your SDSUid account. Complete the steps in the email to activate your account. More information about SDSUid is available at sdsuid.sdsu.edu.

Step 3: Register for the Writing Placement Assessment (WPA) Exam

All undergraduates must demonstrate competency in writing skills at the upper division level as a requirement for the baccalaureate degree awarded by a California State University (CSU) campus. At San Diego State University, this graduation requirement is known as the Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR). Transfer students are eligible to take the WPA once they receive an offer of admission. More information regarding test dates is available at www.sdsu.edu/testoffice.

Step 4: Apply for Financial Aid and Scholarships

Step 5: Review Immunization Requirements

Step 6: Pay Basic Tuition and Fees

Basic tuition and fees are due a few weeks before your class registration date. You will receive an email in early June telling you to go to **My Registration** in your SDSU WebPortal for your class registration date and fee payment information. Pay your fees by your fee payment deadline using the Student Account Services website at www.sdsu.edu/sas in order to register on your assigned registration date.

Step 7: Attend New Student Orientation

New Student Orientation for transfers is offered in August. Do not make travel arrangements before you have made a reservation for New Student Orientation. Space is limited for each orientation program (to allow students to make connections and register for classes). You can make your reservation online at www.sdsu.edu/orientation beginning on May 9 at 10 a.m. PST.
