

TRANSFER STEPS TO ENROLL

Welcome, Class of 2022!

As an admitted transfer student, you must complete the following steps to finalize your admission. For detailed instructions on each step, please visit sdsu.edu/admittedtransfers.

☐ **Step 1: Complete Your Intent to Enroll**

Reserve your place in the class of 2022 by submitting the online Intent to Enroll \$400 nonrefundable deposit in your SDSU WebPortal at sdsu.edu/portal. Additionally, please send official copies of transcript(s) from all colleges you have attended. Transcripts including fall 2019 grades are due May 1, 2020 and transcripts including spring 2020 grades are due June 30, 2020. Please note that SDSU will accept only electronic transcripts from the schools listed at sdsu.edu/electronictranscripts. Also, you will need to send official Advanced Placement and IB scores, if applicable.

☐ **Step 2: Activate Your SDSUid**

Once you submit your Intent to Enroll, you will receive an email with instructions on how to activate your SDSUid account. Complete the steps in the email to activate your account. More information about SDSUid is available at sdsuid.sdsu.edu.

☐ **Step 3: Apply for Financial Aid**

It's time to decide how you and your family will finance your SDSU education. Learn more about applying for financial aid by visiting sdsu.edu/financialaid.

☐ **Step 4: Complete Immunization Requirements**

All students must meet specific immunization requirements. Log in to the **HealthConnect portal** and upload your proof of immunizations and your Tuberculosis (TB) Risk Assessment. Visit the **Immunization Requirements website** ahead of time to review the requirements that apply to you and begin working with your healthcare professional to ensure you have completed all of the required immunizations. Make sure you have acceptable proof of completed immunizations available for submission. Acceptable proof includes records from your high school, private healthcare provider, local health department, or campus health center.

☐ **Step 5: Pay Basic Tuition and Fees**

Basic tuition and fees are due two weeks before your **New Student Orientation** date, which is the day that you will register for classes. Log in to your **Online Student Account** and pay your Basic Tuition and Fees. Students from outside California must pay their additional nonresident tuition before the first day of classes.

☐ **Step 6: Attend New Student Orientation and Register for Classes**

New Student Orientation for transfers is offered in August. Do not make travel arrangements before you have made a reservation for New Student Orientation. Space is limited for each orientation program (to allow students to make connections and register for classes). You can make your reservation online at sdsu.edu/orientation beginning on May 12 at 10 a.m. PST.
